

# GEORGETOWN DAYS 2010

## ARTISAN & CRAFT FAIR

### Rules and Regulations

- Rental fee and SASE (Self Addressed Stamped Envelope) must accompany application. Please make all checks payable to the Georgetown Days. All spaces are outdoors and are 10' x 10' and cost \$25.00. The fair will run from 10:00 am until 3:00pm.
- No display or stock is to be removed during fair hours, even if you sell out. Please leave your area the way you found it. All spaces will be outdoors on the green behind the Peabody Memorial Library.
- All fees are non-refundable, unless due to injury or illness. Refunds will be considered if we are able to re-book your reserved space.
- This event is outdoors, Rain or Shine.
- Upon acceptance, crafters will receive a confirmation letter with directions. If you will not be able to attend, please let the craft fair committee know as soon as possible by contacting Sandy Gerraughty at (978) 500-5483 or e-mail at [georgetowndays@yahoo.com](mailto:georgetowndays@yahoo.com).
- The Georgetown Days Artisan & Craft Fair is not juried. Applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis. Anyone with handmade crafts or specialty food items is invited to apply. No Imports Or Store-Bought Items Allowed. All products displayed **must** be made by you or someone in your family. No imported jewelry or sweaters, No wholesale wood products, etc. Any Artisan or Crafter wishing to display in the Artisan/Crafter designated area selling items that are not handmade will be asked to leave and will not be invited back to the fair.
- In addition to the Artisan and Craft fair, there will be a separate designated area for local businesses and non-profit groups to display if they do not have a business in the downtown area of Georgetown to do a sidewalk sale as part of the Alliance for Georgetown event.
- Businesses and non-profit groups wishing to display in Library Park must complete a different application. Please e-mail [georgetowndays@yahoo.com](mailto:georgetowndays@yahoo.com) for the application.
- Both areas will be **clearly marked** to designate Artisans & Crafters from Businesses.
- Publicity will include local newspapers, cable television, posters, flyers and memos sent home with school children.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for, and supply his/her own display, including tables & chairs, tents, awnings.
- Set up time is Sunday morning from 8:00 am to 9:45 am. Please unload your vehicle within the designated areas, move your vehicle, and then set up so that other crafters will be able to do the same. We will do our best to have student volunteers available to assist – but they are not guaranteed. Any crafter that hasn't checked in by 9:00 a.m. on Sunday is subject to forfeit their space without a refund.
- **Raffles or drawings of any kind by artisans and/or crafters will not be allowed.**
- All crafters are required to send in photos of items they will be displaying. We will keep a copy on file.
- The Town of Georgetown and any other official sponsor of Georgetown Days are not liable for injury, damage, or losses of any kind that may occur during Georgetown Days.
- Any questions or concerns on the day of the fair should be brought to the attention of a member of the Georgetown Days committee.
- All decisions made by the craft fair committee are final.
